Course Description: Structured Literacy Case Study based on International Dyslexia Association Symposium

Objectives: Identify a strategy, technique, or teaching method learned at the Symposium, determine rationale, and incorporate it into lesson plans to deliver to student(s). Following teaching, compose a narrative to explain and reflect upon the rationale.

Requirements:

- 1) Attend the International Dyslexia Symposium on October 20th, 2017. Notre Dame College provides 1 graduate credit to those who apply (pass/fail grading system).
- 2) To apply for graduate credit, you must register online (\$260 for 1 graduate credit) and complete further assignments. You must conduct a case study with an individual or group of students. The deadline to register for graduate credit is October 25th, 2017. All assignments are due by December 1st, 2017.
 - *Reflect on one specific strategy, technique, or teaching method you learned from the Symposium.
 - *Identify the rationale for the specific strategy and explain educational significance in the teaching environment you currently work in, or plan to pursue.
 - *Locate 3 additional resources, such as books, articles, or journals that support the use of the strategy. (See additional bibliography, if needed)
 - *Prepare the case study: Identify student(s) who could benefit from strategy, including age, grade, disability, school environment/placement.
 - *Teach: Carry out lessons that support your rationale, include 3 lesson plans at a minimum. Lesson plans must include rationale, objectives, summary of tasks, references, and reflection.
 - *Reflect: Submit a 3-page double-spaced narrative with APA documentation, with an additional reference and title page, explaining your rationale for the case study and your outcomes from teaching. Be sure to include ideas for future teaching.
