


# Blessings OF FIELDS





Notre Dame College has been blessed with two gifts to create on-campus athletic fields, and both facilities were blessed by College Chaplain Fr. Edward E. Mehok—and publicly named in honor of their benefactors—during Homecoming and Alumni Reunion Weekend 2013.

The new College Road playing surface was christened formally as Normandy Field, while the facility on South Green Road was officially designated as Mueller Field.

The fields' names honor donations to Notre Dame from Normandy Catering and its Executive Vice President and Director of Culinary Operations Sandy and Linda Carmigiano and from Cincinnati natives Herb and Ann Mueller, who have a grandson who plays football at the College.

In addition to the prayer from the chaplain, dedication ceremonies for the fields included the presentation of a proclamation from South Euclid, Ohio, Mayor Georgine Welo and South Euclid City Council Representative David Miller, as well as recognition of the donors.

The fields are transforming Notre Dame's campus into a full educational experience, to include sport and fitness, for students—and converting the city into a true college town.
