### **PY 307 Behavioral Science Research Methods 4 cr.**

This course provides students with an introduction to the research methods most commonly used in the behavioral sciences. Also, emphasis will be placed on the ethical issues involved in human subject research. An important aspect of the course is getting students prepared to read academic, peer-reviewed journal articles and to write an APA style research proposal or research report. Prerequisites: PY 201, PY 222. (Student learning outcomes 1, 2, 3, 4)

The course meets on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 12:00-1:15.
